The extension is absolutely free! Start your advertising campaign with more than 800 million active users on board. So easy, right?

- The customers can register with their Facebook accounts only
- All product pages have the Like feature
- Magento Facebook Connect module is available for free!

Overall information

It is very convenient for clients to log in to the store, using their Facebook accounts with the help of Magento Facebook Connect. Customers' Facebook account information is perfectly applicable for successful registrations.

Using Magento Facebook Connect Free Extension, you will keep up with customers' preferences and continue advertising your store.

In addition, our company suggests customizing the Log In button in the backend to complement your store design.

The Login feature is useful for all Magento stores. It is both a free advertisement method and a smart teaser for general public.

2. How to Install

Step 1: Use FTP client to upload all folders from the zip package to your Magento site root folder. Be sure that you upload them to the correct directories.

Attention! If your template is not default, be sure to change the folders of the installed module from `/app/design/frontend/default/default` to

`/app/design/frontend/YOUR_PACKAGE/YOUR_THEME` and `/skin/frontend/default/default` to `/skin/frontend/YOUR_PACKAGE/YOUR_THEME`

Step 2: Login to your Magento administration panel

Step 3: Disable compilation (go to System > Tools > Compilation and select Disable) and refresh cache (go to System > Cache Management and select Refresh)

Recommended: Navigate to System > Configuration, if you can see Facebook Connect and Like tab, the extension is installed right.

Step 4: Rlogin to admin panel (log out and back into Magento Admin Panel).

Step 5: Go to System > Configuration > Facebook Connect and Like and choose the right settings of extension.

Recommended: You may go to the frontend and try to check out. This will help you to be sure that Facebook Connect and Like is working.

Step 6: If your compilation is disabled, go to System > Tools > Compilation and select Enable.

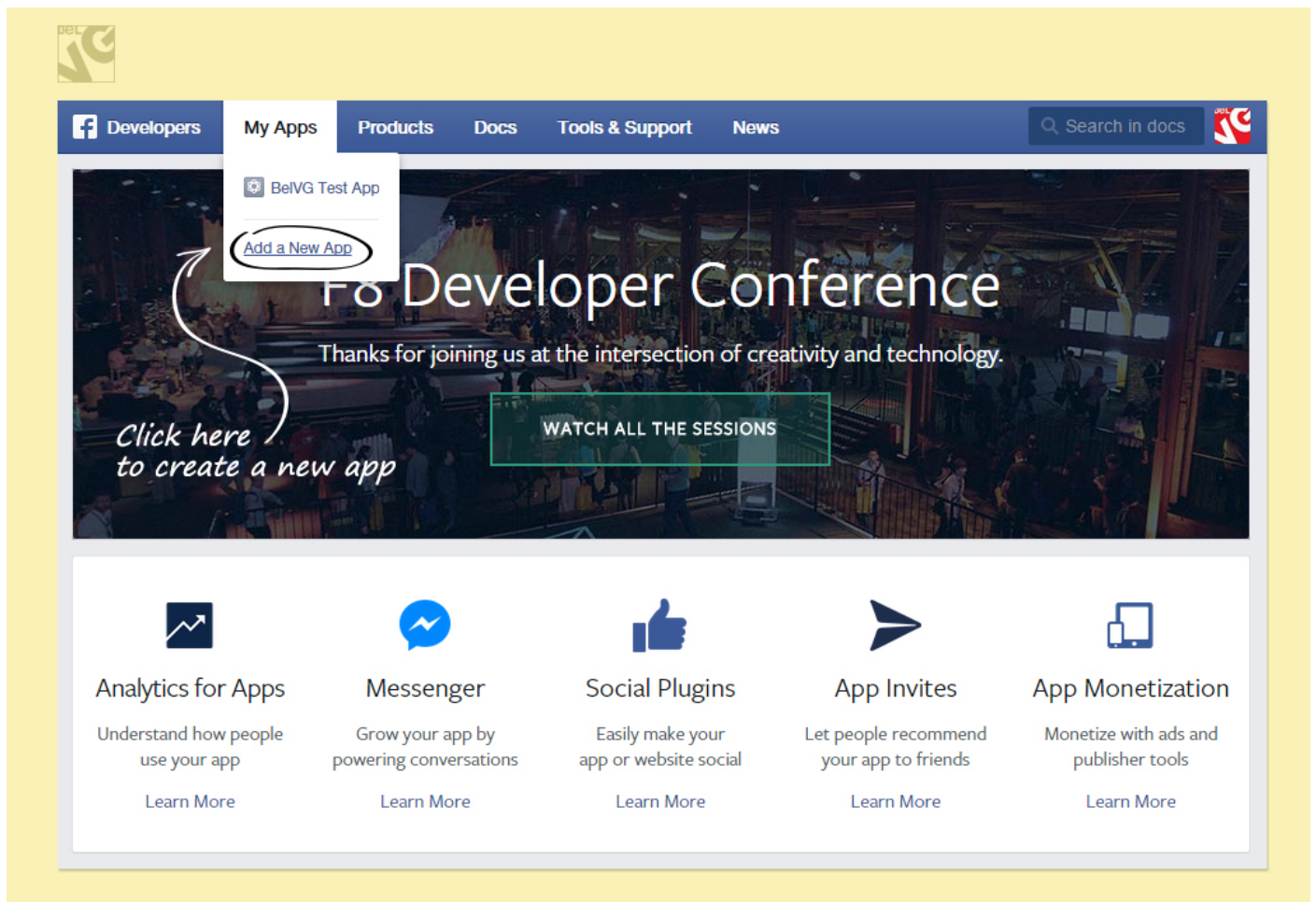
That's all! Enjoy the Facebook Connect and Like performance.

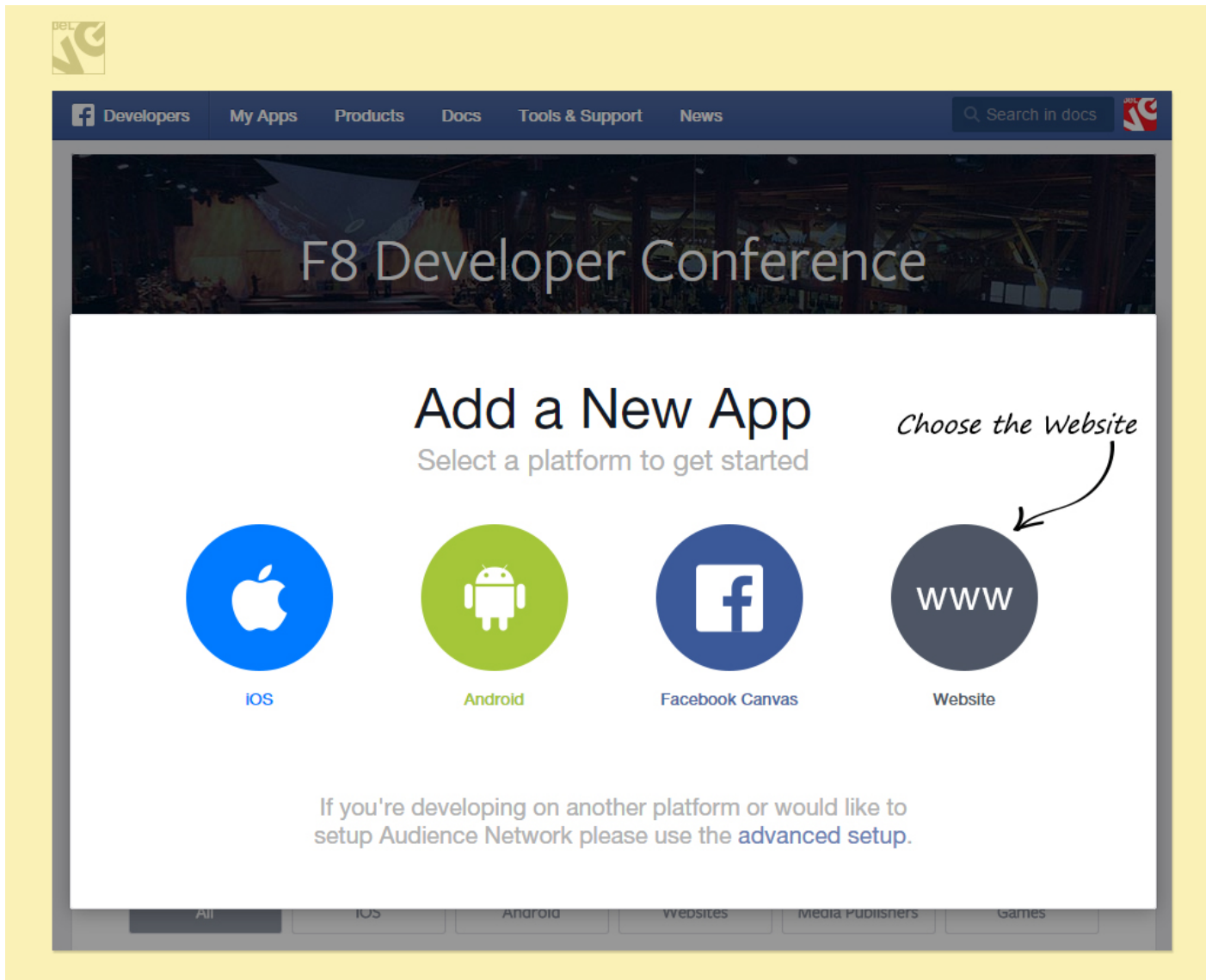

3. How to Create Facebook App

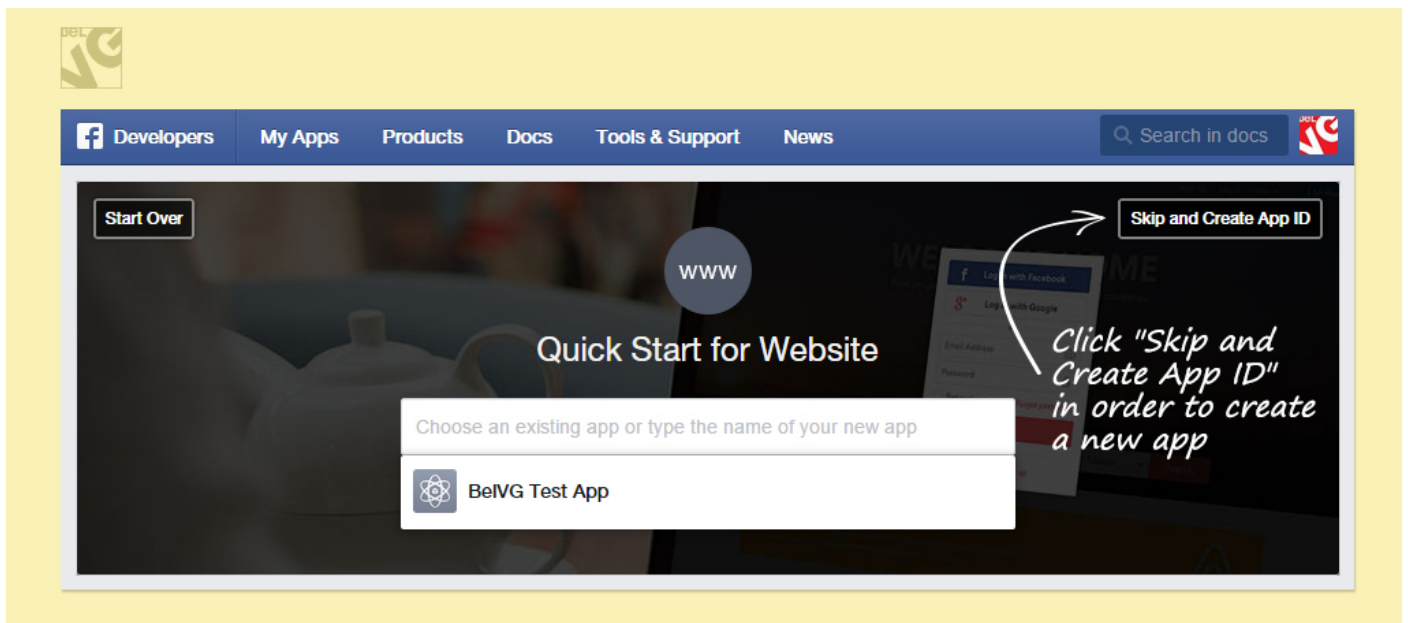
To create a Facebook app you need to go to the <http://developers.facebook.com/> and choose **Apps – Create a New App**.



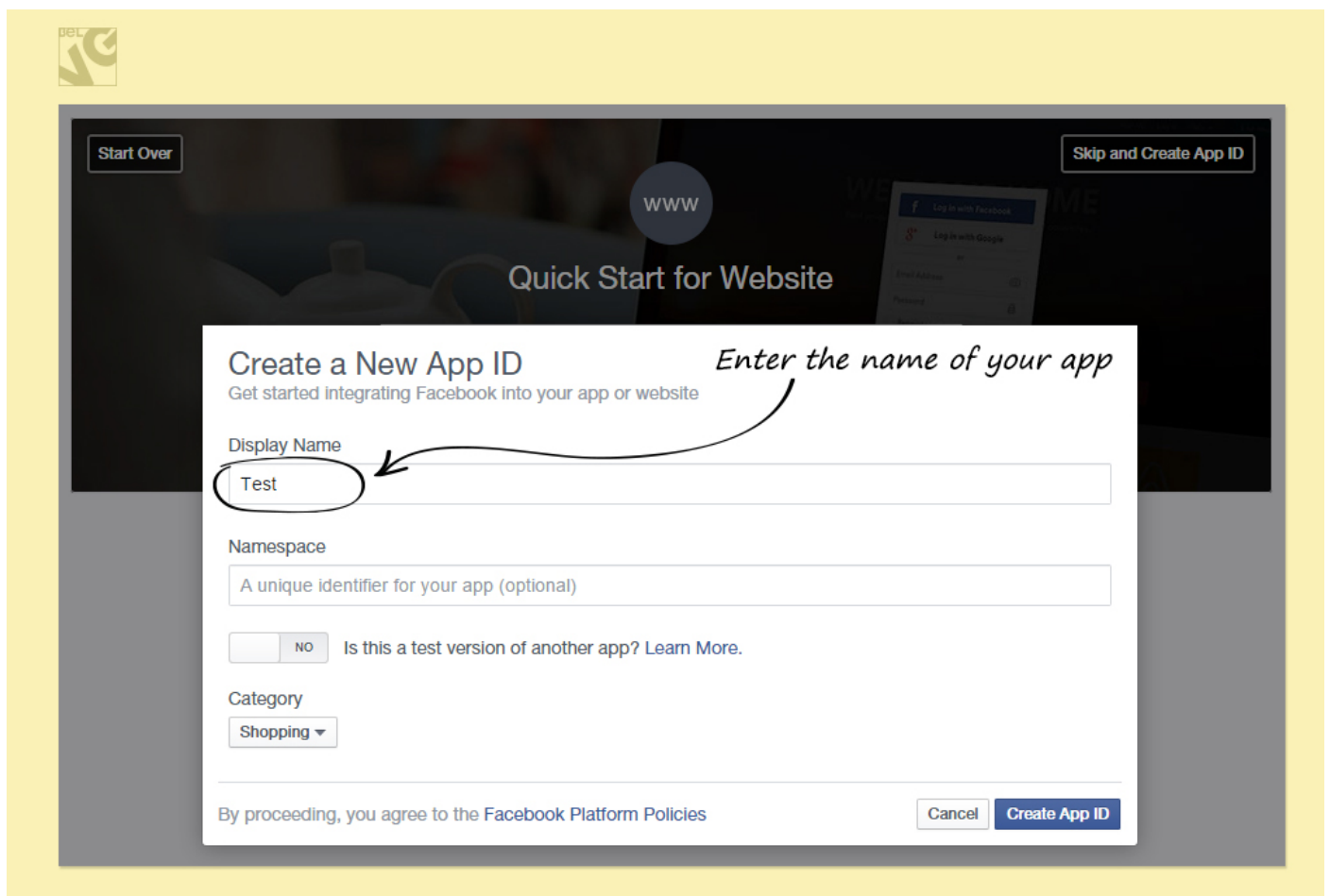
Choose the Website in the popup.



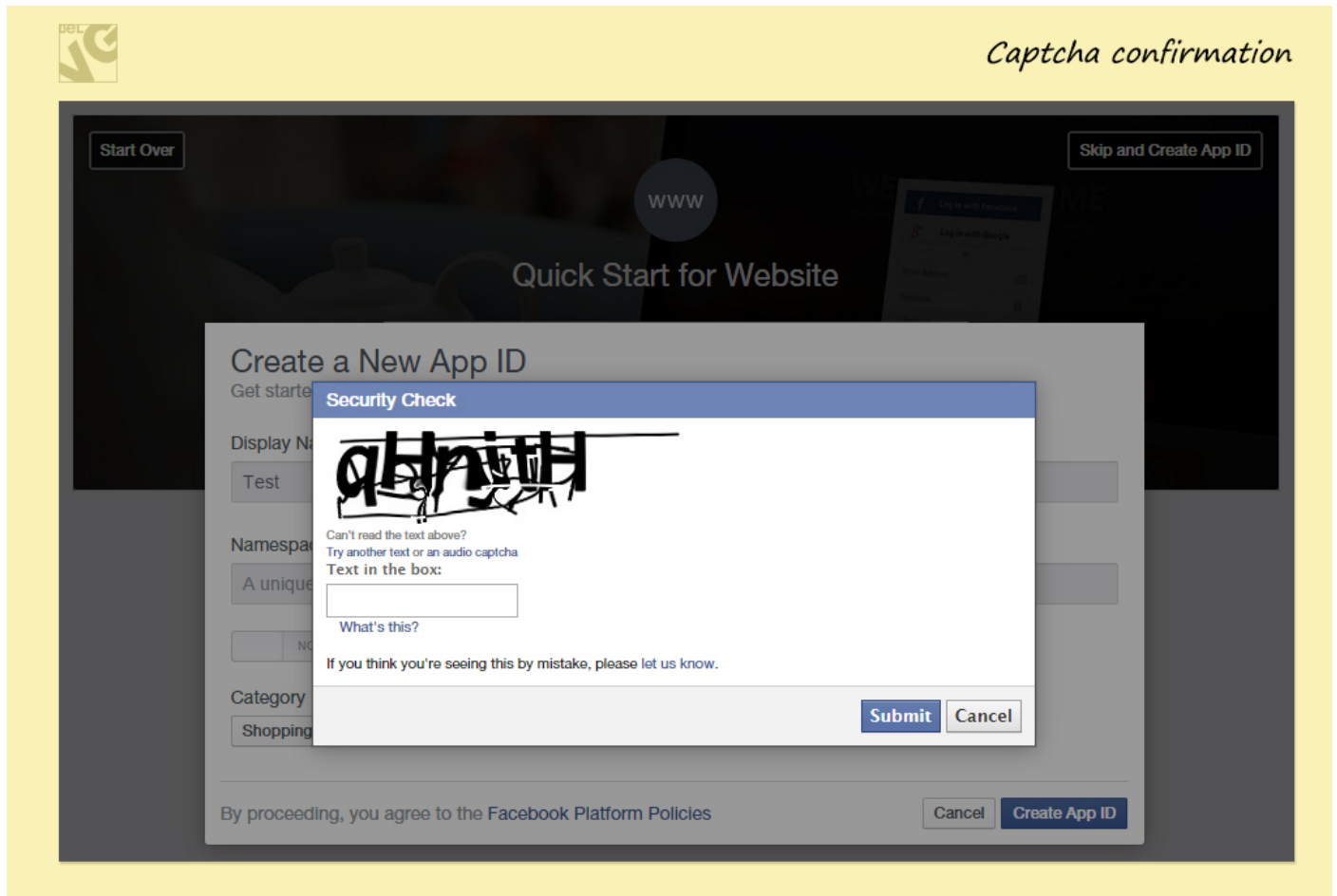
Click “Skip and Create App ID” in order to create a new app.




Name your app and push the **Create App** button.

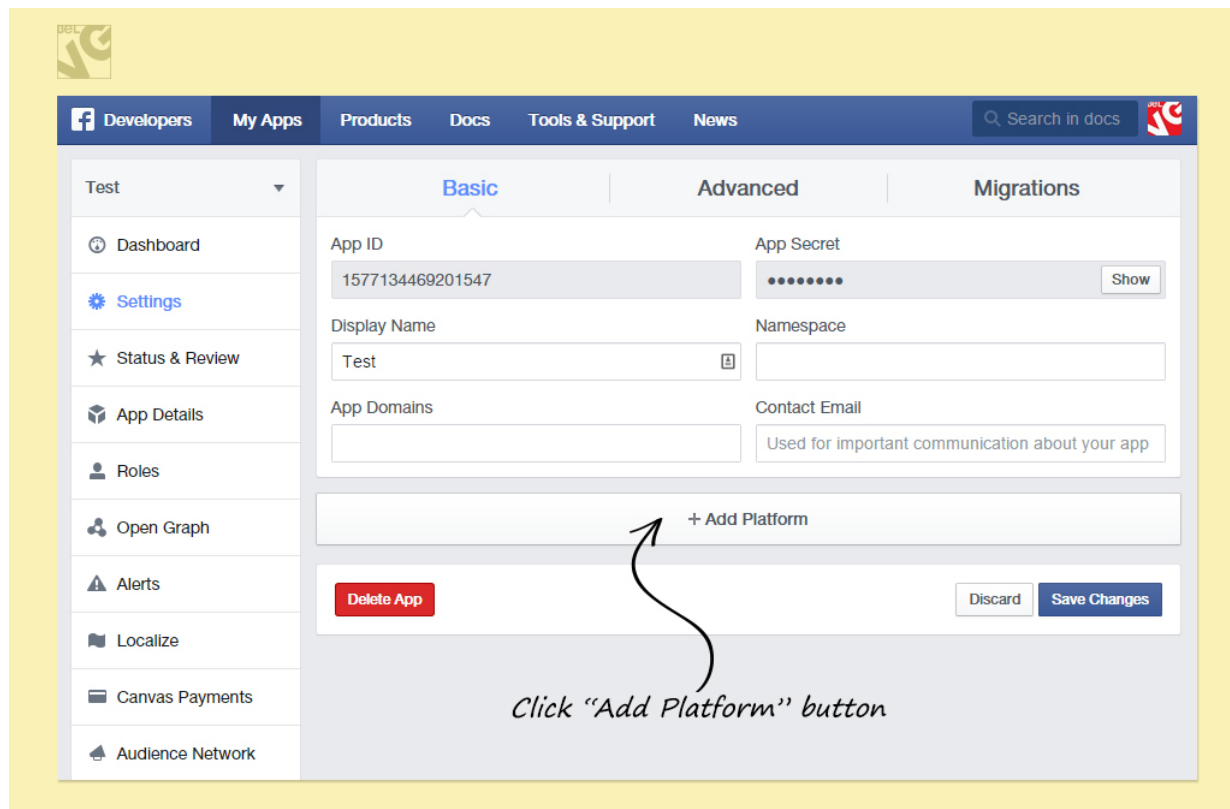

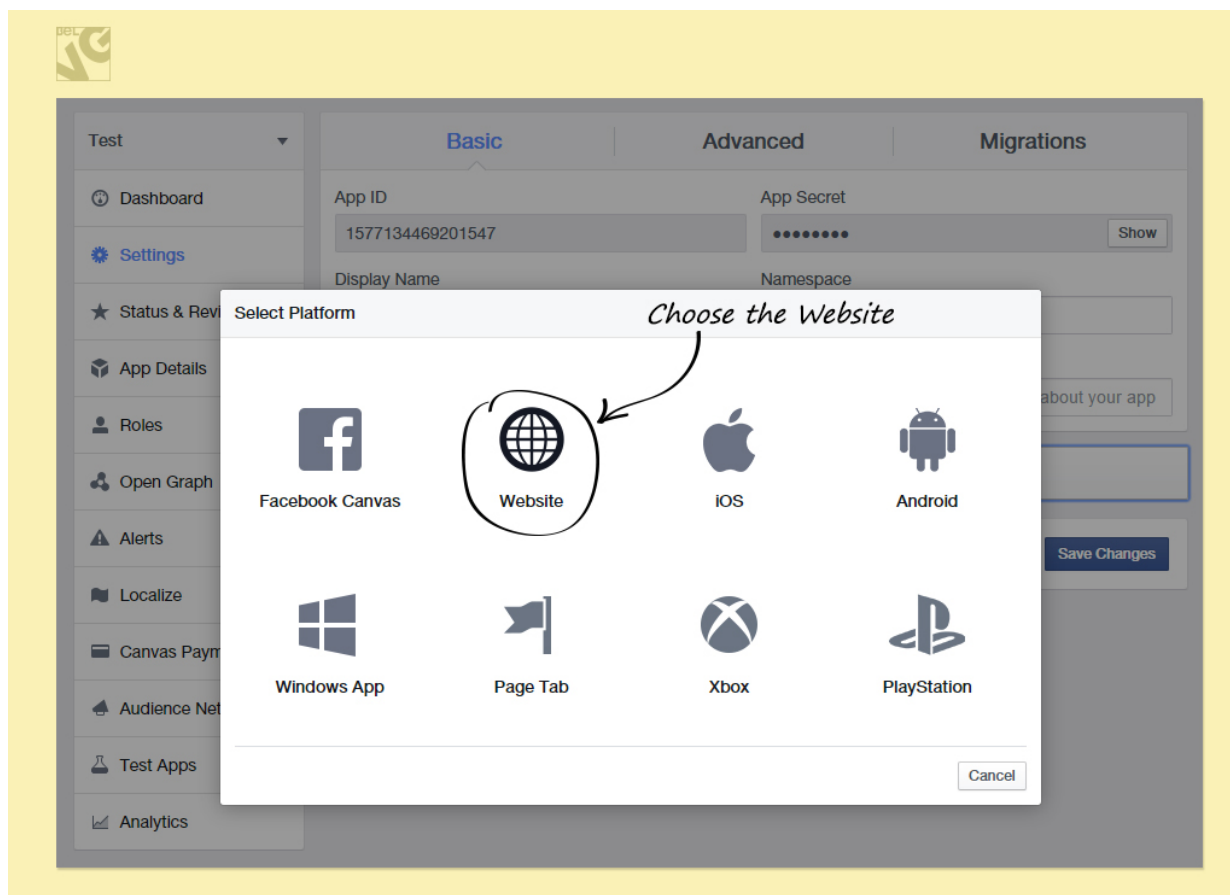

Then go to the **Settings Tab** and click **Add Platform** button.




Choose the **Website** in the popup window.

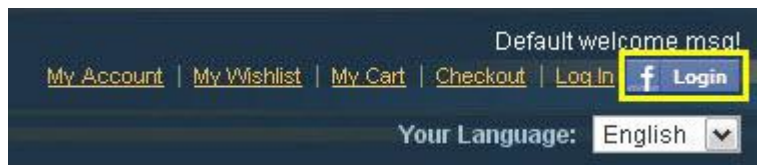

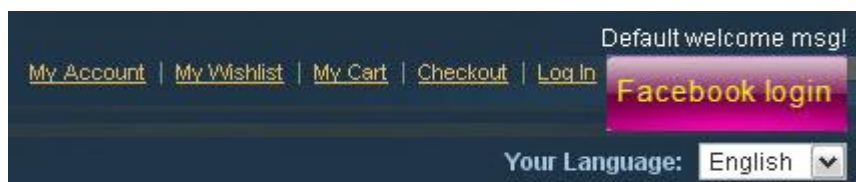

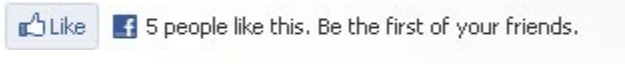

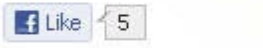

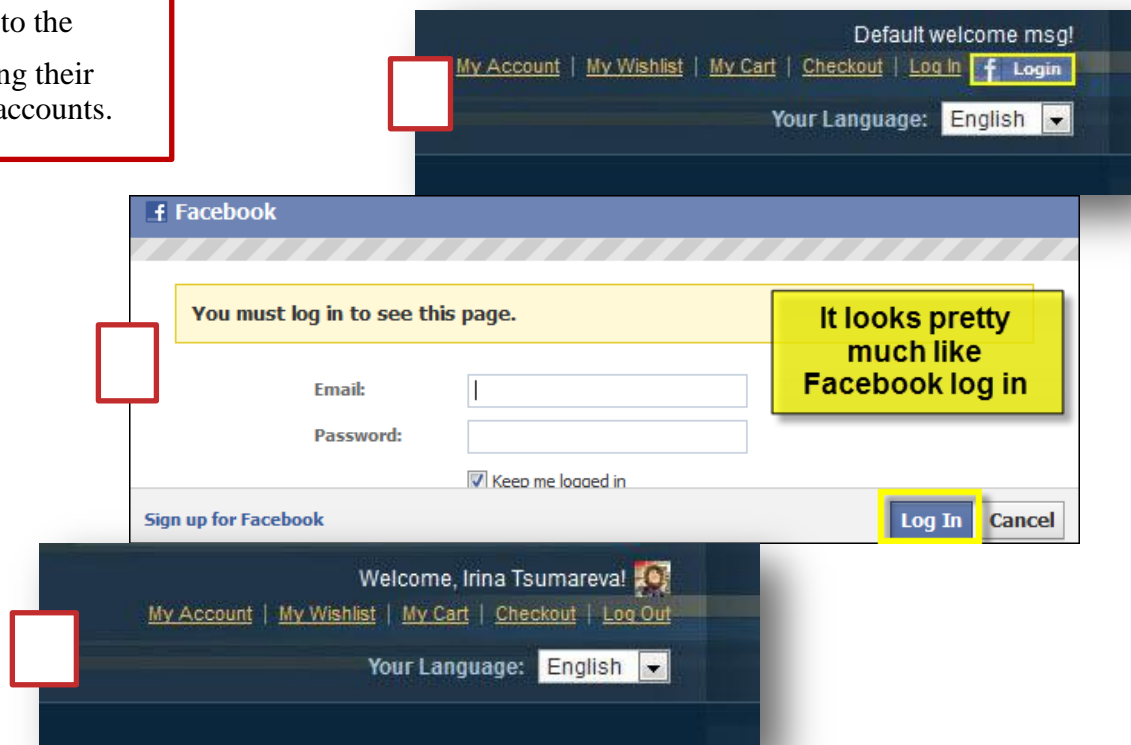


5. How to Use

5.1. How to log in with Facebook account

6. Frequently Asked Questions

The extension doesn't work on my theme! What should I do?

- ✓ Your template may be too customized, lacking or overwriting necessary parts. The extension is delivered as it is, but we can help you customize your theme to make the extension work with it. Please, contact us by using the form on our [website](#).

Facebook Connect Free works fine with the standard theme (on 1.6.1). Which steps are necessary to include in custom themes?

- ✓ The module should work fine with standard themes and work with other themes as usual. Sometimes the template is too customized or specific. In such cases the module should be customized. There are no standard steps with unique theme, because most frequently it is the front-end work. Please, communicate with your developer to find out the solution. Also you may write us a message on store@belvg.com, and we can tell you our quote for your store.

I'm using 1.6.1 Magento version. The extension is installed well but it doesn't appear on the product page. What's wrong with it?

- ✓ Your template is rather non-standard. In this case we recommend customizing the module. Please, contact your developer or write us on store@belvg.com. Probably there is a conflict between some modules on your store.

I need to enter Application ID and Secret Key on settings page to activate the extension. Where can I find this information?

- ✓ You receive Application ID and Secret Key when you create your Facebook application. Write down these data to use it later in activation of your extension.









I set up the extension but finally I have a message “An error occurred with [YOUR_APP_NAME]. Please try again later.” What’s going on?

- ✓ You need to go back to Facebook Creating App page and reenter your site address into the Site URL field.
